Job Description

Purpose

Working within a collaborative team environment incorporating the School at Preston campus, the post holder will provide clinical teaching, supervision and training for the DClinDent, BDSi and CDT courses within the Preston Dental Clinic.

Duties

- To work closely with the Course Leads and Senior Clinical Teachers to ensure delivery of the clinical curriculum.
- 2. To provide clinical skills teaching and supervision, collaborating closely with the Senior Lecturer in pre-clinical teaching with regards to curriculum requirements.
- 3. To take responsibility for student learning and operative work, including assistance and intervention in procedures, as deemed necessary.
- 4. To provide feedback to students on all aspects of clinical work and to participate in peer review.
- 5. To assist with maintaining records of student progression and course evaluation.
- 6. To provide lectures, seminars and tutorials for each course and to take part in the assessment of students.
- 7. To work with senior colleagues to implement changes to the curriculum.
- 8. To facilitate and contribute to problem-based learning (PBL) and to act as PBL Tutor and as a Personal Tutor when required.
- 9. With regards to the nature of your role and its impact upon our students, make an active contribution to and support the improvement of the student experience.
- 10. Undertake other relevant duties and responsibilities appropriate to the grade of the post.
